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ITEP Admission Policy (2026–27)

B.A. B.Ed. & B.Sc. B.Ed.

Chaiduar College (Autonomous), a provincialized college of the Government of Assam, received autonomous status from the UGC vide its letter number F.2 – 10/2023 (AC – Policy), dated 28th, March 2025, subsequently ratified by Gauhati University vide its letter number GU/AFF/2025/9373-80, dated 25th April 2025. However, undergraduate degree certificates will continue to be issued by the Gauhati University (the parent University).

The admission into UG courses in Chaiduar College is open to all the eligible students from India but majority of the seats, as per the guidelines and norms of the Government of Assam, are reserved for the students of the state of Assam. Even students from abroad may be admitted in different courses every year as per the guidelines of the Government of Assam and Government of India. The entire admission process of the college is supervised by the Admission Committee of the college and done through the Samarth e-Gov Suite (Samarth Portal) which has been run and managed by the Directorate of Higher Education (DHE), Government of Assam for facilitating admission of all the colleges in a uniform, transparent and time bound manner.

Reservation of Seats

The Government of Assam reservation policy applies:

- UR – 51%
- OBC/MOBC – 27%
- SC – 7%
- ST (P) – 10%
- ST (H) – 5%

Unfilled reserved seats will be transferred to the UR category.

Intake

- **B.A. B.Ed. (ITEP):** 50 seats
- **B.Sc. B.Ed. (ITEP):** 50 seats

Admission Process

Admissions will be made through the **Samarth Portal** (<https://assamadmitep.samarth.ac.in>) based on **NCET scores**. Applicants should regularly check the Samarth Portal and the college websites for admission updates and schedules.

Eligibility

- Passed Higher Secondary (10+2) or equivalent from a recognized board.
- Minimum **50% aggregate marks**
- Relaxation of marks as per Government/NCTE norms for reserved categories.
- Admission is based on the composite NCET score. For language majors (Assamese, Bodo, English), merit is prepared from the four compulsory NCET papers.
- For other majors, the relevant domain (one) subject score is also considered from the available options.
- Eligibility is determined by the aggregate mark of **English + Best Four Subjects** in Class XII.

Science-stream students are eligible for B.Sc. B.Ed. subject to the prescribed subject combinations at the Higher Secondary level.

- passed in Physics and Mathematics for B. Sc. Physics (Major)
- passed in Chemistry and Mathematics or Physics for B. Sc. Chemistry (Major)
- passed in Mathematics for B. Sc. Mathematics (Major)
- passed in Biology and Chemistry for B. Sc. Botany or Zoology (Major)

Outside Assam Students

For the 2026–27 session, **5% of seats** in each programme are reserved for students from outside Assam. Preference will be given to Assam students, and vacant seats may be filled by outside-state candidates.

Admission Formalities

Selected candidates must complete document verification and fee payment as per the DHE schedule. Online verification may be allowed for students from distant locations. Since ITEP is a **self-financed programme**, fees prescribed by the college are applicable.

- The fee details and other details of the programme are available in the Chaiduar College (Autonomous) ITEP website (<https://itep.chaiduarcollege.ac.in>).
- If the seats remain vacant in any course(s) after the publications of the merit lists as notified in the Samarth Portal, the remaining seats will be filled up through Spot Admission. **The spot admission will be guided by the Spot Admission Policy of the College.**

Spot Admission

Vacant seats after regular admission will be filled through Spot Admission under categories such as:

- Sports
- Cultural
- Literary
- NCC (B Certificate)
- HS Passed from Chaiduar College
- Tea Garden Labour (TGL)
- Fringe Villages
- Employee Quota
- Other special categories approved by the college

Applications will be accepted offline/online as notified. Original documents are required at admission. If students fail to submit the original documents at the time of spot admission, their applications may be rejected. However, additional time may be granted to the students on valid ground. If seats remain vacant after the spot admission, the Office of the Principal will decide on admitting students on case to case basis on any of the above mentioned quotas till seats are filled up.

Special Achievement

Students with outstanding achievements in sports, culture, literature or other recognized fields may be considered under special quota by applying with supporting certificates to cdc.principal.gohpur@gmail.com.

Preference in self-financed courses will be given to Assam students, particularly those from neighbouring and fringe areas.

Hostel Admission

Hostel accommodation (approximately **100 seats for girls** and **40 seats for boys**, subject to vacancy) is allotted on merit, considering distance from the college. Students must indicate hostel preference while applying through the Samarth Portal.
